Carer's Rights Day and Young Carers

Carer's rights day is on the **23rd of November** and aims to highlight unpaid carer's rights to access services and look after their health and well-being as well as provide information and support in caring for family members, friends and partners. On the day Carer's Support Centre is offering a meet-up to find out more information and give South Glos and Bristol Councils feedback on your experiences of adult social care. They're also offering **free lunch and pampering sessions to all carers.** If you want to attend this takes place at The Vassall Centre in Fishponds and you can sign up to attend in person by leaving a voice message on 0117 958 9902 or go to www.carerssupportcentre.org.uk/carers-rights-day-2023/ to attend online and get more information.

We would also like to highlight young carers who often do not recognise or reach out that they may be carers. If you are or know someone who supports family who is 18 or under, even by doing things such as shopping and cleaning for parents, helping to look after siblings or interpreting it will be useful to speak to someone you trust at school and ask them to refer you to Carers Support Centre. This way we can support you with caring and provide benefits such as free flu vaccinations. Don't forget to let us know if you register as a carer.

Blood Pressure Checks

If you are aged 40 or over and haven't had your blood pressure checked in the last 6 months you're eligible to have a free check at a pharmacy which offers the community blood pressure service. You can also come in to Orchard and have your blood pressure checked in the waiting room for free. Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month— November

We would like to highlight some important aspects of Pancreatic Cancer.

Pancreatic cancer has had the lowest five-year survival improvement over the last 45 years at only 6.9% increase and currently more than half of people diagnosed with pancreatic cancer die in 3 months of the diagnosis.

Pancreatic Cancer UK are hosting fundraising challenges for the 24 people who die from pancreatic cancer in the UK such as walking or cycling 24 miles in November.

They are also petitioning to the government to get faster treatment as currently 7 in 10 people with pancreatic cancer never receive any treatment at all.

Remembrance Day and Veteran Support..11th November

Op FORTITUDE is a new dedicated referral pathway for homeless veterans aiming to support 1,300 veterans over 2 years and can be contacted on 01748 8337797.

Op RESTORE: The Veterans Physical Health and Wellbeing Service is for anyone who has served at least one day in UK Armed Forces and, because of their service, acquired a significant and lasting physical illness or Injury. This service provides specialist care and treatment for veterans who have physical health problems and works alongside Op COURAGE: The Veterans Mental Health and Wellbeing Service

If you meet the criteria ask your GP, they will be able to offer a referral to Op RESTORE and/or Op COURAGE.

It doesn't matter how long ago you left the Armed Forces or how long you served for. Please get in touch.
